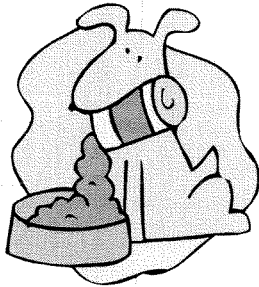
1. Mrs. Moore took her 4th grade class of 25 students to the aquarium. Admission for each student was \$12. What was the total amount of money needed for the field trip?

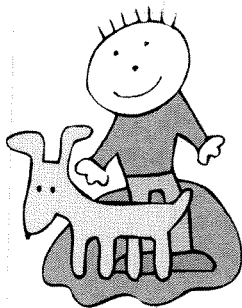
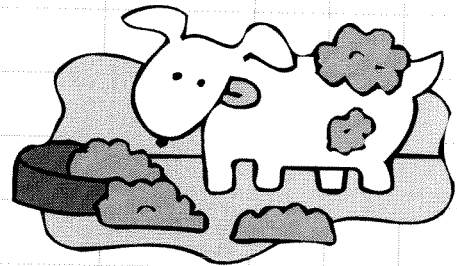

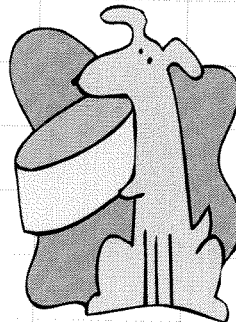
